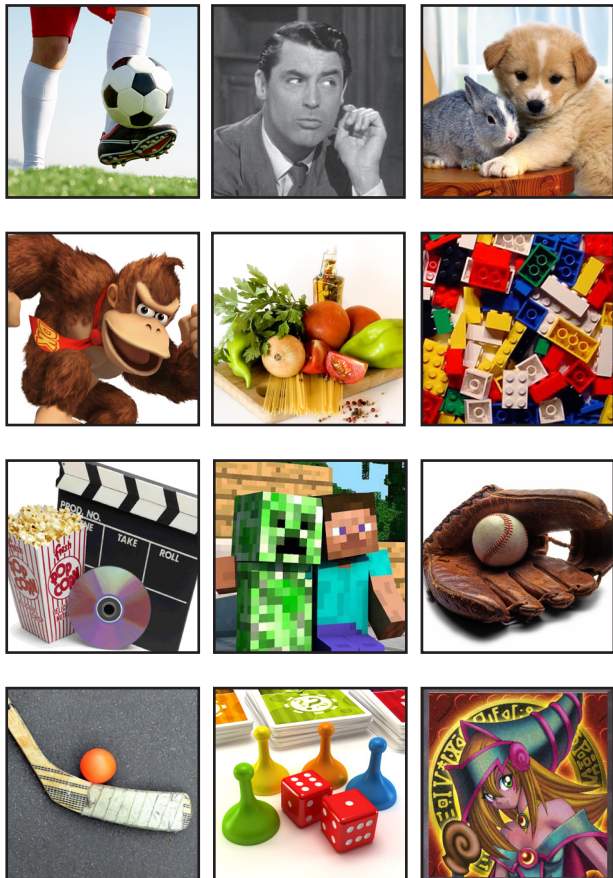


AFTERSCHOOL CLUBS
